

1. Go to page templates and choose "Built in: Basic" from the drop down menu



2. A number of options will come up for templates. Click on the template called "BRICK" and drag it to your blank workpage.



3. Your page should look like this:



TITLE:

- 1. Drag the item into the first box
- 2. A window will pop up and write in what you want. NOTE: if you want words to go underneath another you will have to drag in a new for each line



- 3. Click on "Place Lettering"
- 4. If you click on the word after and blue dots are around the edge, you can click on these and drag them to change the shape of your word. If you click on the word after and green dots are around the edge, you can click on these and drag them to change the size of your word. The purple arrow is for rotation of your word

PICTURES:

- 1. Open Safari and search for images relating to the first box on your "Chain of Cause and Effect" sheet
- 2. Drag the full size image from safari into the second box of your comic
- 3. Find a picture for the second box on your "Chain of Cause and Effect" sheet
- 4. Drag the full size image from safari into the third box of your comic
- 5. Continue for the other boxes

ADDING TEXT:

1. Drag the ABCD... box into each of your boxes



- 2. Write one sentence describing what is the cause or effect for each cell
- 3. If your text is too small or to big, select the text and click on "Bigger" or "Smaller"



ADDING COLOUR:
