

Getting the video files


- go into Student Common → Hand Outs → Tripp → Video Files
- Drag these files to the iPhoto icon on your doc



- If any pop-up windows come up when iPhoto starts just close them
- Make sure the videos are in iPhoto; if not drag the files again
- Now close iPhoto

Starting iMovie


- Click on the iMovie icon on your doc



- If any pop-up windows come up when iMovie starts just close them
- One of the pop-ups you should see is this




- Click on “NOW”; if you do not see this window, close iMovie and go back to iPhoto and re-import the video files
- iMovie should look something like this:



Making a movie:


- At the top of the screen click on the header “HELP” then “video tutorials”



- This will take you to a webpage
- Along the side is a list of video tutorials watch a bunch of them
- REMEMBER: you can always pause the video tutorial and then go and try it out on iMovie then go back to the video

Editing your parts together:


- To make a movie you need to arrange the clips that you want in an order that you want
- In the frame that has all the video that you imported find a clip that you like by running your mouse over it
- Click on where you want the clip to start
- A yellow frame will form around the clip
- Drag the other end of the yellow frame to where you want the clip to end



- Click and drag the yellow frame to top project gallery
- Before:


- Add all the clips you want to make about a ONE MINUTE movie
- You can move the clips around in a different order if you want

Adding some flair:

- About halfway down the screen on the right side is this toolbar:




- Click on the “T” symbol; this is for titles
- A frame forms showing the number of different titles to choose from
- Hover your mouse over the titles will show you what it does
- Chose one of the titles, click and drag it to the beginning of your clips (NOTE: a green line should tell you where it will go)
- Choose a background and name your movie
- On the toolbar pictured above click on the box with the two triangles in it
- A frame will form listing the transitions
- Transitions are ways that the video moves from one clip to another
- Hover your mouse over the transition will show you what it does
- Choose a transition you want and drag it in between two clips
- Your project should look something like this:



Adding music:

- Make a song in GarageBand
- Click on the music notes on the toolbar pictured above



- Find your song and drag it onto your project
