
IN MATH, WE HAVE COVERED THE 2D AND 3D SHAPES UNIT AND WE ARE NEARLY COMPLETE OUR EXPLORATION OF FRACTIONS & DECIMALS. WE WILL END THE YEAR WITH A STUDY OF GRAPHING AS WELL AS FINISHING OUR MEASUREMENT UNIT. WE COMPLETED THE TELLING TIME PORTION EARLIER IN THE YEAR AND NOW WE WILL STUDY AREA.

IN LANGUAGE ARTS, STUDENTS HAVE BEEN WORKING TOWARDS REFINING AND COMBINING THE VARIOUS NARRATIVE WRITING SKILLS WE HAVE BEEN BUILDING UP TO ALL YEAR. WE WILL CONCLUDE WITH A DRAMATIC NARRATIVE SET TO VIDEO AND AN EXPLORATION OF FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE THROUGH POETRY AND SONG. WE HAVE BEGUN A WHOLE CLASS NOVEL STUDY, TICKET TO CURLEW", THAT LINKS IN WITH THE SOCIAL STUDIES CURRICULUM. THIS WILL LINK IN WITH THE GRAPHING UNIT IN MATH. ON TOP OF AND INTERWOVEN AMONGST ALL OF THIS LEARNING, WE WILL BE GOING ON A NUMBER OF FIELD TRIPS (FORT EDMONTON, MISSION HILL AND LITTLE WHITE SCHOOL HOUSE VISIT, SWIMMING, AND WATERS' FARM), AS WELL AS A NUMBER OF SCHOOL-WIDE ACTIVITIES (TRACK AND FIELD DAY, DINO DODGEBALL DAY, FUN DAY, AND YEAR END ASSEMBLY).
